

MORETON ISLAND

WHERE- Moreton Island QLD (just off Brisbane)

WHEN - We will be leaving Saturday 17th November (after working Bee at Porter's) stopping overnight somewhere to get to Port of Brisbane for 12.00pm ferry departure on Sunday 18th November.

We have booked for 6 nights so we leave the island on Saturday 24th November on the 3.30pm ferry

It's about a 90 minute ferry ride to the island. When we get there, drive off the ferry and head north up the beach (about 12km) to our camping spot –**COMBOYURO POINT**

Set up camp and settle in for 6 days of heaps of 4wd'ing, fishing, snorkelling and just relaxing (suit yourself)

COSTS – Ferry prices are based on the length of vehicle & trailer.

For 2 people, Landcruiser & camper it was about \$400.00 return

Camping is \$6.55 per person per night (QLD National parks)

Vehicle permits \$52.00 per month (QLD National parks)
